South Suburban College's Coding Specialist Program Opens Enrollment for Both Fall and Spring

SOUTH HOLLAND, IL— South Suburban College's Coding Specialist Program is now offering a dual enrollment cycle for the fall and spring semesters. New students will be able to take prerequisites or the first semester of Coding classes this fall starting on August 19th or during spring semester in January of 2020. The Coding Specialist Program provides specialized training in a variety of settings where diagnostic and procedural data are coded for reimbursement and other data collection purposes.

The Coding Specialist Program at SSC is approved by the American Health Information Management Association (AHIMA) Foundation for Professional Certificate Approval Programs (PCAP). Upon successful completion of the program, students are eligible to sit for the following coding exams administered by the AHIMA:

- Certified Coding Specialist-Physician Based (CCS-P)
- Certified Coding Specialist (CCS)

Coding is a full time program offered on SSC's Main Campus in South Holland with a few selected courses available at the college's Oak Forest Center. The Coding prerequisites include:

- Completion of MTH 093, RDG 082, ENG 099 or comparable placement scores
- HIT 100 (Foundations of Health Information Technology); must take at SSC
- HIT 103 (Medical Terminology)
- BIO 115 (Human Body Structure)
- HIT 108 (Pathophysiology with Pharmacology)
