## Health Care Industry Night Coming to South Suburban College November 18<sup>th</sup>

SOUTH HOLLAND, IL—South Suburban College is hosting a Health Care Industry Night on Monday, November 18<sup>th</sup> from 5-8 p.m. in the college's Performing Arts Center. The event will include informational sessions and a panel discussion about SSC's Nursing and Community Health Worker Programs, as well as its new Patient Care Technician Program. Industry leaders and SSC instructors will be on hand to answer questions about the career outlook and curriculum.
